Subject: Households at risk of poverty or social exclusion

The most recent data published by Eurostat regarding people at risk of poverty or social exclusion, by age group, show that in several EU countries children and people of active age are at greater risk of poverty or social exclusion than elderly people. In Romania, 51 % of children live in a household at risk of poverty or social exclusion – the largest percentage of any EU country.

What are the Commission's recommendations for improving the lives of Romanian children living in a household at risk of poverty or social exclusion?
