Subject: Humanitarian crisis in Pakistan

More than 190 children have died, and 22 000 have been hospitalised, in Pakistan's Tharparkar district in 2016 because of drought-related waterborne and viral diseases. Tharparkar is facing severe drought for the fourth consecutive year, and access to health services is reported to be very difficult, with families travelling an average distance of 17 km to reach the nearest health facility. The security situation remains volatile owing to militant attacks in urban centres and military operations against the Taliban in tribal areas. Some 1.1 million people remain displaced within Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and the Federally Administered Tribal Areas. The needs of internally displaced persons and of Afghan refugees are of particular concern.

How does the Commission intend to contribute to the humanitarian assistance needed?
