## Question for written answer E-002060/2016 to the Commission Rule 130 Helga Stevens (ECR)

Subject: Postponement of the revision of the regulation on social security systems (Regulation (EC) No 883/2004)

A proposal has been made for a targeted revision of the Posted Workers Directive (Directive 96/71/EC). The revision will not affect the EU rules on social security laid down in the coordinating regulation, Regulation (EC) No 883/2004, however. Under that regulation, posted workers can pay social security contributions in their country of origin for the first two years, which makes it difficult to create a level playing field.

- 1. Does the Commission think that the two-year period in question should be retained?
- 2. If so, is this purely for administrative reasons?
- 3. What other measures is the Commission considering in this area to make the European job market fairer?
