Subject: Progress report on the implementation of the European Union's 2013-2020 Drugs Strategy and 2013-2016 Action Plan on Drugs

In its progress report on the implementation of the European Union's 2013–2020 Drugs Strategy and 2013–2016 Action Plan on Drugs, presented on 27 November 2015, the Commission reported on crime associated with drugs sold over the internet and action by Eurojust and Europol in this field.

1. Can the Commission give an account of the action taken by Eurojust and Europol with regard to the sale of drugs over the internet?

The report also mentions preparations for an extraordinary session of the United Nations General Assembly on drugs (UNGASS 2016), to be held in New York in April 2016.

2. Can the Commission say more about the common European position? Does it intend to redefine its drugs policy in the light of UNGASS 2016?
3. As regards cooperation with third countries, can the Commission describe the current situation with regard to its cooperation with Afghanistan, the biggest opium producer in the world?
