- 2. Does the Commission plan to take steps to improve access to parcel services as well as the quality of parcel services?
- 3. Is the Commission monitoring the work carried out by the Member States to implement Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on alternative dispute resolution for consumer disputes and amending Regulation (EC) No 2006/2004 and Directive 2009/22/EC (Directive on consumer ADR)? If so, what conclusions has it reached?
