Subject: Central register of radical imams

The Danish government and parliament have unanimously decided to adopt legislation to counter the harmful influence and hateful, racist and anti-Semitic speech of radical imams preaching in Salafist mosques across the country.

According to the leader of the Social Democrats, Mette Frederiksen, 'an imam who preaches hate one day in London should not be allowed to travel freely to Berlin or Copenhagen the next.'

A list of undesirable imams should be created in order to deny their entry into Denmark.

Does the Commission intend to establish a central register of radical imams in order to deny their entry into the European Union and their subsequent stay here?
