Subject: Security in EU institution buildings

In the light of the terrible acts committed by Islamic terrorists, security in the EU institutions should be reviewed carefully. Any gap in the external security of buildings, underground car parks and similar may be used for terrorist attacks.

Does the Commission have plans to systematically review security, or the lack thereof, in the EU institution buildings?

Does the Commission know, for example, what materials the new entrance doors at the European Parliament are made of, and have the materials and the swing doors been tested for susceptibility to penetration?

Has the Commission considered following the example of standards used by national parliaments – such as the Danish Parliament – in this area?
