Subject: Compulsory first-aid courses in EU institutions

Following the horrendous terrorist attacks on 22 March 2016 it has become clear how important it is to be able to offer first aid to those harmed in an attack. Bleeding has to be stopped as quickly as possible, hearts restarted and pain relief administered. In the light of the high level of threat to the EU institutions, it might be worth considering offering free, compulsory first-aid courses to all the EU institutions during working hours.

How does the Commission view the idea of compulsory first-aid courses for MEPs and selected staff members in the EU institutions?

What measures will the Commission undertake in this respect?
