Subject: The 'Odysseus' European volunteering project

On 17 March the Italian Prime Minister, Matteo Renzi, announced a proposal to set up the 'Odysseus' project for voluntary service in Europe. This main aim of this initiative is for young people to regain their trust in the EU, which has been eroded as a result of their current difficulties.
