Subject: Containing the bluetongue outbreak

Since a bluetongue epidemic affecting cattle, sheep and goats was identified in France in September 2015, we have seen how the disease has spread to 78 of France's 100 departments, with a total of 237 cases recorded to date.

In accordance with Directive 2000/75/EC laying down specific provisions for the control and eradication of bluetongue, France has increased the restriction zone to a radius of 150 km around the centre of infection.

Given the concern that the epidemic may reach Spain:

- 1. Does the Commission take the view that sufficient action has been taken thus far to contain and halt the epidemic?
- 2. Does the Commission intend to take action in support of the producers affected by the disease?
