Subject: Registering the entry and exit of non-EU nationals

In the wake of the terrorist attacks in Paris and Brussels, in which hundreds of people were killed, it is clear that security in the EU is inadequate. I realise that in some cases the terrorists are born and brought up in the EU, but in other cases they travel to Europe without any proper security checks being carried out.

Is the Commission going to introduce proper entry and exit registration for people travelling to and from the EU, along the lines of the procedure used in the USA?

And does the Commission agree, furthermore, that in order for Schengen cooperation to continue, there must be effective control at the EU's external borders, including checks on all those entering the Union?
