Question for written answer E-003429/2016 to the Commission Rule 130 Beatrix von Storch (EFDD)

Subject: Amendment to Directive 91/477/EEC: financial impact and compensation

The Commission has not answered Question E-000182/2016 concerning the financial impact and compensation costs of its proposed amendment to Directive 91/477/EEC on control of the acquisition and possession of weapons.

The Commission evidently cannot indicate the compensation costs for the more than 100 million non-shooting replicas or give a figure for the loss of artefacts by the deactivation of museum-owned firearms. This gives the impression that, when drafting the proposal for a directive, the financial impact on citizens of the Member States was not assessed at all.

- 1. When drafting the proposal, did the Commission estimate the financial impact or not?
- 2. What are the real administration (red tape) costs for each of more than 2 million registered category A and B7 firearms?
- 3. What are the compensation costs for the more than 100 million non-shooting replicas and how serious is the loss of artefacts by the deactivation of museum-owned firearms?
