Subject: Towards improved single market regulation (2015/2089(INI))

Legislation on the single market should aim to improve the functioning of the single market and serve to boost competitiveness, innovation, economic growth and job creation. Effective impact assessments are an important tool for informing policymakers about how best to design the regulation to achieve those aims and single market objectives, and also about the potential effects of its interplay with existing legislation. Therefore:

1. Will the Commission propose measures aiming to increase cooperation between different support services, such as 'Your Europe' and SOLVIT, in an effort to improve user satisfaction? If so, when?
2. When will it carry out an assessment of data provided under the 'Your Europe' and SOLVIT programmes?
