Subject: Requirements governing core network corridors and development of the Rhine Valley railway (Germany)

The Rheintalbahn (Rhine Valley railway) is in one of the core network corridors of the Trans-European Transport Networks (TEN-T). I would like to ask the Commission the following questions:

- 1. Under EU law, what requirements govern the design speed of railway infrastructure in the context of the promotion of core network corridors?
- 2. Is it possible to reduce the design speed from v(max)=250 km/h to v(max)=200 km/h or v(max)=230 km/h in the case of a funding application which has already been made?
