Subject: Equal rights for all

Ensuring that migrants do not experience discrimination on Member States' labour markets, in order to improve their chances of being rapidly integrated, is one of the priorities of pro-Europeans. It is constantly reiterated that migrants must be able to benefit from the same rights as European citizens, and many programmes under the EU budget have been expanded in order to support those policies.
