Subject: Idomeni camp

It has been reported that on 9 May 2016 the Greek police, in an attempt to force refugees to evacuate the refugee camp at Idomeni in Greece, began blocking food supplies from NGOs and international organisations that are usually distributed to families and migrants in need.

It seems that the Greek authorities have declared that the Idomeni camp is closed and are actively encouraging people to move out.

Does the Commission intend to take action to resettle the 10 000 refugees currently living in the camp who, if evacuated, will be in immediate need of shelter, food and medical assistance?
