Subject: Getting out of Belgium during the next terrorist attack

During the latest terrorist attack on 22 March 2016, it proved impossible to get out of Belgium. Aircraft, trains, the underground, buses and rental cars turned out, in practice, to be unusable by the vast majority of people during a terrorist attack.

Does the Commission have the power to offer cars without vehicle registration charges and road tax for individuals linked to EU institutions, or, if that is not the case, will it approach the relevant Belgian authorities in this connection?

Or can the Commission guarantee in some other way that it will be possible to get out of Brussels during the next attack?
