Subject: UK host universities in the Erasmus exchange programme

In May 2016 the Commission replied to written question E-002906/2016 stating the number of students sent from the UK to participate in the Erasmus programme between 2000 and 2014, namely 144 000. The numbers of students participating have grown every year.
