Subject: UK universities sending Erasmus students

In its answer to written question E-002906/16, the Commission stated that the UK ranks as the fifth biggest 'sending country' involved in the Erasmus programme. On the basis of the data available for the period from 2000 to 2014, the Commission further revealed that 144 000 students from the UK had participated in the programme, with numbers growing ever year.

Could the Commission therefore provide a breakdown of which universities from the UK are sending such students?
