Subject: Implementation of corrective actions related to stress tests at the Almaraz nuclear power plant and cross-border cooperation in the event of a nuclear emergency

The report by the Spanish National Safety Council on the stress tests at the Almaraz nuclear power plant highlighted a number of safety weaknesses that needed putting right.

Which of the corrective actions mentioned in the report have still not been implemented?

As regards the recommendations made by the European Nuclear Safety Regulators Group (ENSREG) in the peer review of severe accident management plans, which ones have yet to be implemented?

Can the Commission ensure that the Spanish and Portuguese authorities would have effective joint emergency coordination systems if a severe accident were to occur at a nuclear power plant?
