Subject: European citizens' access to key information on financing programmes

Given the information published by the European Commission on the grants that it offers under different direct financing programmes, I appreciate the fact that bureaucracy has been eliminated completely and access therefore simplified by making the application online-only.

However, will the web pages of the Commission agencies managing these competitions – such as Chafea (Consumers, Health, Agriculture and Food Executive Agency), where the applications are published – be translated into all official languages, rather than only English, French and/or German?

Translation of this information would further improve European citizens' access to the grants offered by the European Commission, as language is often a barrier for access to information, particularly cross-border information.
