Subject: Energy efficiency and renewable energy at the European Institutions

On 23 June 2016, the European Parliament voted on the progress report on renewable energy in the EU. Paragraph 79, stating that the European Institutions must set a good example in the field of renewable energy, was approved by a large majority.
