Subject: EU migration policy

The European migrant crisis continues to worsen. Ordinary Europeans are suffering the consequences, as terrorists make their way into Europe undetected amid the influx of people.

Slaves to their own ideology, EU leaders have rushed headlong into a misguided liberal policy, with no consideration for the views of a majority of Europeans, who quite rightly associate the influx of refugees with the terrorist threat. Europe is now paying the price for doing away with its internal borders.
