Subject: VP/HR - Drug trafficking in Indonesia

The Philippines' 'war on drugs' is a brutal, unlawful assault on the rule of law and universal human rights protections that has targeted some of the country's poorest, most marginalised citizens.

The head of Indonesia's National Narcotics Agency (BNN), Comr. Gen. Budi Waseso, has called for police to emulate the Philippines' 'war on drugs' declared by President Rodrigo Duterte.

Will the VP/HR hold talks with the Government of Indonesia in order to ensure that it rejects Duterte's appalling 'solution' to the complex problems of drugs and criminality, and emphasise the obligation of police and other security forces to respect everyone's basic human rights?
