Subject: EU Emergency Support Instrument

On 10 September 2016, the Commissioner for Humanitarian Aid and Crisis Management announced EUR 115 million in additional funding under the EU Emergency Support Instrument to improve living conditions for refugees, migrants and asylum seekers in Greece. Earlier this year, EU officials said that the Mediterranean route was slowing down and less migrants were arriving, but in recent weeks thousands of migrants have been arriving weekly.

How does the Commission intend to deliver this emergency support to the refugees in need, and how will it ensure that the aid is well spent? Under what conditions can the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) and the Internal Security Fund (ISF) be used in emergency situations?
