Subject: EU culture budget

For the multiannual financial framework 2014-2020, a decision was taken to establish 'Creative Europe', bringing the Culture Programme 2007-2013 and the Media Programme 2017-2014 together in a single programme. The budget for this programme has been increased by 9% to EUR 1.462 billion, despite the fact that general spending has been reduced by EUR 6 billion.

This financial framework makes provision for investment amounting to EUR 325 149 million over the period 2014-2020. However, in contrast to the period 2007-2013, it is unclear what proportion of the EU structural funds will be used for cultural investment according to:

- type of structural fund;
- beneficiary Member State;
- area of investment in line with its final purpose (heritage, infrastructure or cultural services).
- 1. What proportion of the EUR 325 149 million from the EU structural funds was spent on culture in 2014?
- 2. Which funds did the money come from and what was it used for (cultural heritage, infrastructure development or cultural services)?
- 3. Which Member States received money from the EU structural funds for cultural investment and how much did they receive?
