Subject: Economic development disparities between EU Member States

According to a study published by the Bertelsmann foundation on 18 August 2016, economic development disparities between EU Member States have grown. The Nordic Member States are showing stronger economic performance than the southern Member States, which have suffered from the crisis and austerity policies. However, economic disparities are intensifying in all of these Member States.
