Question for written answer E-007415/2016 to the Commission Rule 130 Therese Comodini Cachia (PPE)

Subject: Protection for outdoor workers

Recent studies show that outdoor workers run double the risk of developing non-melanoma skin cancer compared to the general population. Solar ultraviolet radiation is classified by the WHO as a Group 1 carcinogen. Only a few Member States recognise ultraviolet skin-cancer as an occupational disease, but the uptake of benefit entitlements has also been hampered by lack of awareness.

- 1. Does the Commission intend to extend the scope of EU-level health and safety standards on radiation exposure limits beyond artificial sources of radiation so as to include natural exposure?
- 2. Does the Commission intend to develop new policies and measures at European level in order to protect outdoor workers?
- 3. How does the Commission intend to raise awareness about the dangers of solar ultraviolet radiation?
