Subject: Relocation and resettlement of migrants

Current figures confirm that the policy of relocation and resettlement of people presumed to be refugees has so far been disastrous. The Commission has said that in one year 5 651 people have been relocated from Greece, but only 1 196 from Italy. In view of the recent migrant tragedies and the ever greater number of migrants who have arrived in Italy, the majority of them illegally:

- How does the Commission plan to relocate, in line with the initial agreements, the remaining 154 349 refugees in Member States?
- Will it keep to the two-year timescale initially agreed when the agreement was signed?
