Subject: Tobacco: combating smuggling and promoting price harmonisation in the EU

French tobacconists are the first to notice any developments in the shadow tobacco market, which is an out-and-out scourge that nullifies almost all the efforts being made in the field of public health communication. The shadow tobacco market accounts for around 27% of all cigarettes bought in France. It is market that is fuelled by smuggling, but also through cross-border purchases.

- 1. What national and European measures has the Commission identified or does it intend to establish to combat the smuggling of tobacco from outside the EU and within its borders?
- 2. Does the Commission not feel that genuine harmonisation of tobacco prices across Europe could be a means of combating this illegal trade more effectively?

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
