Subject: Interpretation in the work of FARNET

The European Fisheries Areas Network (FARNET) helps promote cooperation among stakeholders at local level as part of the aim of developing fisheries areas with the help of the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund. FARNET is therefore a very important network, and it has been very successful.

Some partners feel, however, that they are unable to enjoy full access to FARNET's work because interpretation is not always provided into the Commission's working languages (English, French and German).

Could the Commission therefore ensure that interpretation into those three languages is always provided for FARNET's business, if necessary by cutting down on other operating expenditure such as transport and accommodation costs?
