Subject: Call for projects to tackle radicalisation in prison

In its first report on progress towards an effective and sustainable Security Union, published on 12 October 2016, the Commission states that 'following the October 2015 High-Level Conference on the Criminal justice response to radicalisation, and the 20 November 2015 Council Conclusions, Member States are currently submitting proposals in response to a call for projects to address radicalisation in prison'.

Even though the radicalisation of Europeans constitutes a major threat within Europe's borders, their radicalisation in prison all too often remains overlooked in view of the complexity of the issue. The EU and its Member States are facing a desperate lack of tangible measures for preventing radicalisation in Europe's prisons. It is therefore up to the EU to promote the exchange of good practices in this field.

- 1. Can the Commission therefore give details of this call for projects, and specify the provisional timetable for the receipt of proposals from the Member States?
- 2. Does the Commission intend also to notify the European Parliament of the outcome of this call for projects?
