The impact assessment that was published along with the proposal of 28 September 2016 on the review of dual-use export control noted that the current EU export control system was not fully adapted to keep up with 'today's evolving and new security risks, rapid technological and scientific developments as well as transformations in trade and economic processes'.

Will the EU take into account the emerging trade in cyber-surveillance technology and the risks it creates for international security and human rights in its review of dual-use export controls?
