Subject: Media literacy

Having regard to:

- the Council conclusions of November 2014 on European audiovisual policy in the digital era, which invite the Commission and the Member States to promote good practices and research on the inclusion of media literacy in formal education and training, as well as in non-formal and informal learning,
- the Council conclusions of 30 May 2016 on developing media literacy and critical thinking through education and training,
- Article 15 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council establishing Creative Europe on promoting transnational policy cooperation, according to which the cross-sectoral strand is to support, inter alia, 'conferences, seminars and policy dialogue, including in the field of cultural and media literacy',

when will the Commission decide to include media literacy in the annual work programmes for Creative Europe?
