Subject: Public safety: dangers posed by foreign fighters

According to certain reports in the Italian media in recent days, a number of young people enrolled with Isis could return to Europe and plan terrorist attacks. Particular mention may be made of the case of Padua, where the judge responsible for pre-trial orders has warned of the risks posed by returning foreign fighters, citing the case of a girl who had enrolled with Isis and, according to certain intercepts and messages, was about to return to Italy.

In view of the difficult situation with regard to public safety and the constant terrorist threat, can the Commission indicate:

- whether it is aware of these cases in which Isis fighters may be planning to return to Europe?
- whether it intends to take all necessary measures to prevent foreign fighters from returning to their countries?
