Subject: Labour exploitation of migrants

According to the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights, serious exploitation at work is tending to rise with the latest waves of migration. The integration of migrants, broadly encouraged by EU schemes and with exceptional funding being released, has not had the expected results. Apart from a few very highly publicised cases, the labour market integration of migrants continues to be problematic.

What specific tools does the Commission intend to use to combat the exploitation of migrant workers?
