Subject: Visa-free travel for all European citizens

The EU is entitled to expect symmetry in its relations with the USA as regards the introduction of visa-free travel for all European citizens. There is no justification for excluding the citizens of certain Member States, e.g. Poland and Croatia, especially since the old reasons for such an exclusion, relating to worries over a huge wave of economic migration from eastern and southern Europe, are no longer relevant.

Does the Commission intend to take up the issue of visas for EU citizens in her discussions with the new US administration?
