Subject: Unfair trading practices in the food supply chain

On 14 November, the Agricultural Markets Task Force presented a series of recommendations to the Commission.¹ Given this report and the conclusions of the Council of Agriculture Ministers, which acknowledged that there is an imbalance in the food supply chain due to the vulnerable position of farmers,²

- 1. Does the Commission intend to enact legislation to address unfair trading practices in the food supply chain?
- 2. Does the Commission intend to prioritise the enforcement of EU rules on imported fruit and vegetable products?
- 3. Does the Commission intend to establish a common framework and set minimum production and invoicing conditions for producer organisations to be classed as fruit and vegetable producer organisations?
