Subject: Anti-dumping measures against imports of Chinese steel

We welcome the Commission's decision to impose definitive anti-dumping duties on imports of certain heavy plates of non-alloy steel from China. Although this measure to protect European steel production has come late, the fact is that our demands for an investigation to be launched against China were successful.

Those of us who support globalisation and international trade being governed by rules are heartened that the procedures for taking action against this kind of dumping actually work. We believe that Europe should activate such mechanisms not only when products are sold below production cost, but also where human rights are infringed, where minimum working conditions are not complied with and international environmental standards are not respected.

In that context,

1. Does the Commission intend to implement anti-dumping measures for other types of steel products?
2. Is the Commission considering imposing anti-dumping measures in other industrial sectors?
3. If so, in which ones?
