Question for written answer E-002106/2017 to the Commission Rule 130 Franck Proust (PPE)

Subject: Horizon 2020/next Research and Development Framework Programme

I was elected in a European constituency in which the space and aeronautics industry is a cornerstone of our regional economy. The industry is at the cutting edge of research and innovation and requires an ever-increasing amount of financing as its programmes become more and more demanding and competitive. These are suffering in particular from a reduction in public donations. Such donations have an incomparable leverage effect on mobilising private funds and often prove the determining factor in launching a research programme.

Given the new challenges which the industry must face (environmental footprint, increased competition from emerging countries...), the Commission is asked to reply to the following questions:

- 1. Does the Commission plan to make space and aeronautics priorities in the mid-term revision of the Horizon 2020 programme?
- 2. Has the Commission identified the investment priorities in these sectors which would increase the financial resources (such as direct grants) for the next Research and Development Framework Programme?
