Subject: Action Plan on HIV/AIDS

According to UNAIDS data for 2015, HIV affects 36.7 million people worldwide, of whom 60% are women. What is more, 1.1 million people have died from AIDS-related illnesses.

UNAIDS targets for 2020 include the 90-90-90 objective, which is intended to ensure that 90% of people with HIV are aware of their condition, 90% of those who know that they have the infection are receiving treatment and 90% of those receiving treatment experience a suppression of viral load.

We will be closer than ever to achieving effective infection control within the next four years if governments and international organisations respond to the challenges and needs of this worldwide epidemic.

The latest EU Action Plan on HIV/AIDS was completed recently. What is the assessment of this latest plan and what measures will the Commission take to achieve the 90-90-90 objective?
