Subject: Maximum limits on consumption of intoxicating substances for drivers of motor vehicles

Driving while under the influence of intoxicating substances is a growing problem and a threat to road safety. While Member States have established maximum limits on blood alcohol content for drivers of motor vehicles in their national laws, the same is not the case for intoxicating substances, despite the fact that in 2003 the Council adopted a resolution on combating the impact of psychoactive substances use on road accidents.¹

What is Council doing to encourage Member States to introduce in their national legislation maximum limits on intoxicating substances for drivers of motor vehicles?
