Subject: Residence requirement for EU citizens residing in a Member State other than their own

In Denmark a group of EU citizens have no address in Denmark (no permanent, hotel, campsite or other temporary residence) and so they are homeless and live in the streets or in camps in parks.

Is it possible, under current EU rules, to require a permanent or temporary address for EU citizens residing in a Member State other than their own?
