Subject: Failure to deport non-nationals convicted of criminal offences

According to a report in the *Kronen Zeitung*¹, only a fraction of the non-EU nationals who are already in prison in Austria are being deported to their home countries.

1. Does the Commission plan to compile information concerning the numbers of nationals of non-EU countries and of other EU countries who are in prison in the Member States?
2. Does the Commission think it would be appropriate for Member States to conclude readmission agreements covering nationals of other EU countries who have been convicted of criminal offences?
3. Is the Commission planning to compile statistics on the costs incurred by Member States as a result of the non-deportation of convicted offenders?
