Subject: Failure to deport non-nationals convicted of criminal offences

According to a report in the *Kronen Zeitung*<sup>1</sup>, only a fraction of the non-EU nationals who are already in prison in Austria are being deported to their home countries.

- 1. Does the Commission plan to compile information concerning the numbers of nationals of non-EU countries and of other EU countries who are in prison in the Member States?
- 2. Does the Commission think it would be appropriate for Member States to conclude readmission agreements covering nationals of other EU countries who have been convicted of criminal offences?
- 3. Is the Commission planning to compile statistics on the costs incurred by Member States as a result of the non-deportation of convicted offenders?
