Subject: Migration: what aid for Italy?

Following the closure of the Balkan route, migrants are increasingly using the even more dangerous central Mediterranean crossing. This change of route, combined with ever increasing migratory flows, is bringing Italy to saturation point. The EU cannot remain deaf to the warning cries from Rome, just as it cannot continue to leave Italy to bear the full brunt of European migratory pressure almost alone.

How does the Commission intend to deal with the consequences of the relocation system ending in September 2017? What measures are planned to address the needs both of migrants and the host structures after that date?

What initiatives does the Commission propose to take to help Italy deal with the current migratory flow?
