Subject: Koh-Lanta: the Commission makes SBD 90 million available to boost employment and

prosperity in Vanuatu

On 22 June 2016, the Commission decided to earmark a further EUR 10 million (SBD 90 million) to boost employment and incomes for farmers on Vanuatu, a Pacific island which is not part of the European Union.

The Commission will make a total of EUR 53.5 million available over the period from 2014 to 20201.

- One year later, how many Vanuatu farmers have found jobs?
- By how much has farmers' average income in Vanuatu increased over the same period?
- What is the total amount of the subsidies paid to Vanuatu by the European Union over the last 36 years²?
