Question for written answer E-005272/2017 to the Commission Rule 130 Dominique Martin (ENF)

Subject: Migrants: EUR 10 000 for ethnic cookery courses

On 23 June 2017 the Commission revealed that it is going to fund 'ethnic' cookery courses for 200 'migrants' in Italy at a cost of EUR 2 million¹, or EUR 10 000 per 'migrant'.

- 1. How does the Commission justify the exorbitant cost of those courses?
- 2. Why are non-migrants debarred from access to them?
- 3. Why are 'ethnic' cookery courses being forced on migrants instead of courses in traditional European cuisine, which would provide more opportunities for employment and would be a sign of assimilation?
