- 1. Could the Commission please set out those provisions of the EEA Agreement which fall within EU competence and those provisions of the EEA Agreement which fall within Member States' competence?
- 2. Is it the Commission's opinion that Brexit does not affect the continued application to the UK of those parts of the EEA Agreement for which the UK has competence? And, if so, does the Commission agree that, at least to that extent, the UK is required to give notice pursuant to Article 127 of the EEA Agreement of its withdrawal from that Agreement, if that, indeed, is its wish, and in order to make that withdrawal effective?
