Subject: VP/HR - Bacha bāzī (pederasty) in Afghanistan and Europe's responsibility

Afghanistan's Independent Human Rights Commission considers the practice of *Bacha bāzī* (pederasty) in the country to be a crime and a human rights violation that must be outlawed and prosecuted.

One of the initiatives that the new Elements for an EU Strategy in Afghanistan stresses is support for 'improved child protection'.

- 1. What protocols are the EU's civilian and military representatives working on the ground using to report such crimes to the authorities and to the international community?
- 2. Are EU diplomats, in coordination with our allies the United States, in particular– taking any specific steps to address this human-rights issue?
